


Last month, Jimmy Lee went to India with his father. Mr. Lee wanted to visit his friend Mr. Singh, who lives there with his daughter, Nali.

"Wow," said Jimmy, looking at a hole as big as a baseball. "What happened to it?"




"There is an old story about a secret passage under this temple," said Nali.


